DigiNet Introduction

Some hams avoid operations on the McARCS DigiNet because they think it is too complicated and requires an investment in additional equipment. It does require a computer with a microphone that can hear the transceiver speaker and a speaker that the transceiver microphone can hear but no other equipment is required.

The primary use of the McARCS County-wide diginet (Tuesdays at 8 PM) is to check out the equipment, software, and adjustments and to practice sending formatted messages for use in the aftermath of a disaster, such as a major earthquake. This net uses software known as Narrow Band Emergency Messaging Software (NBEMS) and is recognized as such by the ARRL. <u>https://www.arrl.org/NBEMS</u>
