When we had the fires, shelters were set up with no communications whatsoever We need more qualified shelters – one in Laytonville, Willits, Ukiah?

JJ Lowe, from Santa Rosa, was coming up to tool up the Willits shelter when it was already closed – no way to contact him to call off

Jim & Tim can/will both back-up John

What else does John see in re: to need for coordination between Mendo Cnty and Sonoma Cnty? A HAM radio push, was a group of people were out on a call – they were out in a spot and had 2 flat tires and no cell service. Call "guardian communications", take an HT at a minimum with a mag mount, make sure a home base person knows you're going out and how to communicate
