- o Ideas?

- Objectives: make aware of exercise 1) radios on air, 2) tested (equip), 3) participants capable (of proper radio operation and protocol)
- Secondary: shaking reports, scope of contacts
- o What would it take to get an operator at the dispatch center? Sheriff training center will be EOC
- O Steve hopes to just get people on the air and checked in
- o Leave net open for an hour?
- o Expects MCOE, EOC, & Sheriff EOC on air
- o Test redundant communication
- o Promote local nets versus county net?
- o John would still like to incorporate local clinics
- o If hospital activated take check-ins; target group to get on air
- o If you are a hospital, your primary need is your facility, not community needs. Best to operate out of firehouse where real community communication might take place
- O Dan Rowe (?) came to SAR meeting; plans on putting ERV on the air for Red Cross act as an agency or community facility
- o By 10:30 convene a county wide net; organize and prioritize traffic
- o Activate county-wide; connect after that can we connect outside of the county
- o Emergency check in first, facility check-in, community then general
- What is the role: emergency reporting in lieu of no other communications, then logistics channel (# beds, etc., and finally health and welfare in shelters
