- Website
  - Nothing new to report
- Treasury
  - The current balance is \$849.03
  - John gave Tim a signed (but otherwise blank) check that was going to be used for the Science Fair award. The check can be used for other expenses later on.

#### Items of Discussion

- Science Fair
  - No entries were present that were considered to fall under the club's criteria, so no award money was given out
  - John spoke with an Anderson Valley High School student that participated in the highaltitude balloon experiments, and how ham radio can integrate into such activities.
- EOC dual-band radio microphone
  - o The ground wire in the mic cable broke free from the RJ connector
  - Tim mentioned that there is a modular connector inside of the microphone, so if it is taken apart, the cable can be easily replaced.
  - Quick browsing on eBay shows them mostly being in the \$10-15 range
- Repair/replacement of the EOC HF antenna
  - John's suggestion: make a double dipole out of ladder-line, 80-40m. Center support, with or without integrated balun. 135 ft minimum, 150 ft would be good.
  - John made a spreadsheet with comparisons between many antennas
    - 14ga stranded copper wire ladder line \$1.04/ft
    - 18ga solid copper clad steel ladder line \$0.39/ft
    - W2DU HF balun \$31.99
  - A motion was made to purchase the 14ga stranded ladder line and balun, as well as moving the "antenna party" to Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> (after the Human Race)
  - Nick will contact Jim to let him know of the date change, as he will be arranging to get the lift.
