This was an on-the-air meeting conducted on the county-wide linked computer system. This was conducted as a net with President Nick Wharff, KI6RIT, acting as net control operator from the Emergency Operations Center station.

A major subject of the meeting was confirming the dates for the various public service activities during 2015. The details are posted on the web site under the Events tab. The first event is participation in the national and county tsunami drill tentatively scheduled for March 26. The next event will be providing communications for the annual Ukiah Human Race scheduled for May 2.

It was suggested that the proposed test session should be on April 18 at the county museum. This had been discussed at length via email. The test coordinator is expected to be Ken Alvey, KG6TXU, from Kelseyville. This will be a test-only session with some local Volunteer Examiners participating. President Wharff will coordinate this with the museum and verify that both April 18 for the test session and April 11 for a question and answer session are clear with the museum.

The net closed and operators at the EOC participated in contacts with the Humboldt County HF net and with the California Emergency Services Net, both on 75m.
