Meeting Minutes June 6, 2016

Following the usual practice for even-numbered months, this was an on-the-air meeting held on the county-wide linked repeater system. The meeting was called to order by president KJ6EIF. Checking in were: W6FQX, WA6JBK, KC6MGM, WB9NJS, KI6RIT, and KI6MJC.

This was primarily a Field Day planning review.

W6FQX announced that he had secured permission to use the facilities of the Mendocino County Museum for the venue. He also reported that North Coast Opportunities (NCO) had offered to buy the pizza for Saturday night. In addition he will request a Certificate of Insurance from NCO. He also said that he would be sure to inform the ARRL for listing on their web site.

W6JRC announced that he would make all the public announcements to the newspapers and broadcast radio stations although he would not be participating in the event.

KC6MCM offered to contact a number of elected officials including state and county legislative members and law enforcement.

WA6JBK offered to prepare Sunday morning breakfast for whomever was still there (or came back).

WB9NJS offered to provide all the other food and drinks thought appropriate for the event and would request reimbursement.

KI6RIT offered to prepare a Facebook page announcing the event and also to update the McARCS web site with the event news and a link to the Facebook page.

KI6MJC said that she had the McARCS banner, some sidewalk signs for visitor information, and a pop-up tent for shelter although she would not be attending the event herself.

KJ6EIF said that he would bring the Teen CERT trailer for an operating position.

Other operating positions would be provided by KC6MGM (Jeep), WA6JBK (truck), W6FQX (motorhome) and other tables and chairs as needed.
